2026 Community & Leadership Scholarships

Korowal School is an independent, secular, and co-educational school with programmes from Kindergarten to Year 12. Our School name, 'Korowal', is an Aboriginal word meaning 'to stand alone', or 'the strong one'.

Founded in 1978 in Leura, Korowal School was based around a human-centred philosophy. Within this, we consider that all human beings are of equal worth and capable of reason. We believe that each of us possesses a capacity to solve problems for ourselves in order to flourish. We continue to hold these as core principles today and our values are important to us.

The aspects of education at Korowal which attract many, include:

- Relationship-based teaching and learning
- A focus on creativity, critical thinking and problem solving
- Our Oracy programme which places the child's voice at the centre
- Forging deeper connections to Country
- Inclusive programming and curriculum
- Small class sizes
- A beautiful, natural bush setting
- Exciting and varied co-curricular programme in high school

To be considered for a Community & Leadership Scholarship for 2026, you must complete the ACER Scholarship Test. The ACER Scholarship Test will be held at Korowal School on **Saturday, March 22 at 8.45am.**

Based on the ACER Scholarship Test, previous academic record, and an interview with the Scholarship Committee for shortlisted applicants, scholarships may be offered to students who exhibit qualities compatible with Korowal School's values.

Applications for our 2026 Scholarships will close on **Wednesday, March 12, 2025 at 5pm.** Students entering Year 6, 7, Year 10 and Year 11* in 2026 are eligible to apply. *Please note that Year 11 begins in Week 5, Term 4, 2025.

We will be offering scholarships with up to 25% fee reduction (to be determined on an individual basis).

The duration of the scholarship will typically be for three years. For example, a Year 7 scholarship will be awarded until the end of Year 9 and a Year 10 scholarship until the end of Year 12. A Year 11 scholarship will be awarded until the graduation at the end of Year 12.

Scholarship Criteria

In applying for a scholarship, applicants are expected to fulfil the following criteria:

- Demonstrate leadership in school or the community in which they live
- Demonstrate a commitment to serving their community
- Exemplify Korowal's values (care, curiosity, challenge, creativity, collaboration)
- A particular community service interest that they wish to pursue at Korowal
- How they would contribute significantly and add to the overall life of the school

Application Process

- 1. Registration for the Korowal School Academic Scholarship Program must be completed online via the ACER Scholarship website:
 - a. Registration for Year 6
 - b. Registration for High School
- 2. Registrations must be submitted by Wednesday, March 12, 2025 at 5pm. There is a fee of \$140 per child to register. The fee allows students to register for as many of the categories as they would like in the 2025 Scholarship Test.
- 3. Applicants will need to complete the Korowal Academic Scholarship Application Form (attached) and email it to scholarships@korowal.nsw.edu.au Wednesday, March 12, 2025 at 5pm.
- 4. Applicants sit the ACER Scholarship Test at Korowal School on **Saturday, March 22, 2025** at **8:45am.**
- 5. Upon review of test results and the Korowal Community & Leadership Scholarship Application Form, applicants may be invited to attend an interview with the scholarship committee.
- 6. The applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee.
- 7. Applicants (successful and unsuccessful) will be notified following the interview period.

The regular Korowal School enrolment process would then proceed for the successful candidate/s. This includes interviews with the Year Mentor, or Stage Advisor, and completion of all enrolment processes in line with the School's policies and procedures. The receipt of a Korowal



Scholarship is dependent on completion and acceptance of the enrolment process and being issued a letter of offer of enrolment.

Details of ACER Scholarship Test

On the day of testing, students need to arrive and report by 8.45am to the school Hall. Students will be escorted into the examination by our supervisors. Testing will be finished by 12 noon. Please collect your child promptly at 12 noon.


Latecomers may only be admitted during breaks between tests. If you are late and miss a test, you forfeit the opportunity to sit the test at Korowal School as we are not offering additional test dates.

We will provide your child with pens/pencils and erasers. You should ensure that your child has warm clothing, covered shoes, several adequate snacks and drinks to ensure the comfort of your child during the examination and breaks. Mobile phones, bags and any additional equipment/property must be submitted at the door.

Applicants are required to submit the following parts of the application, each of which will demonstrate how they exemplify the school's values.

- PART 1. Personal Information
- PART 2. School records, such as school reports and NAPLAN
- PART 3. Personal statement
- PART 4. A letter of recommendation from an external community member (who knows your passions)
- PART 5. A letter of recommendation from a teacher who knows you well


