2027 Korowal Foundations Scholarship

Investing in the first years of a lifetime of learning

Korowal School is an independent, secular and co-educational school offering education from Kindergarten to Year 12. Our name, *Korowal*, is an Aboriginal word meaning "*to stand alone*" or "*the strong one*".

Founded in 1978, Korowal has always placed relationships, curiosity and learner agency at the heart of education. Today, these principles continue to guide everything we do.

As the only International Baccalaureate (IB) Primary Years Programme (PYP) Candidate School in the Blue Mountains, Korowal is embracing one of the world's leading approaches to primary education. The PYP is recognised internationally for developing curious, confident and compassionate learners who think deeply, communicate effectively and take meaningful action in the world around them. It complements our long-held philosophy by nurturing children's agency, encouraging them to ask thoughtful questions, make connections across disciplines and become active participants in their own learning.

Our Kindergarten program brings together the very best of play, inquiry and strong foundations. Alongside rich opportunities for exploration and creativity, children develop excellent literacy and numeracy skills through intentional teaching in a warm, caring and connected learning environment.

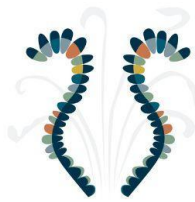
The Korowal Foundations Scholarship has been established to support families who share our educational philosophy and values and who are seeking an exceptional start to their child's learning journey.

At Korowal, we believe a child's success is built on a strong partnership between home and school. We are therefore seeking families who value curiosity, respectful relationships, learner agency and active participation in school life. Scholarship recipients will demonstrate a genuine commitment to these principles and to contributing positively to the life of our community.

Scholarships are awarded for **three years (Kindergarten to Year 2)** and provide up to **75% remission of tuition fees**, determined on an individual basis. Families may apply for a further three-year scholarship at the conclusion of the initial scholarship period.

Korowal School acknowledges the traditional custodians of this land, the Gundungurra and Darug peoples, and pays respect to Elders past and present. We acknowledge their continuing connection to Country and recognise the contribution they make to the life of this region.



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Applications

Applications are considered holistically. The Scholarship Committee will take into account:

- The alignment between the family's values and Korowal's philosophy of education.
 - A commitment to working in partnership with the school.
 - The ways in which the family will contribute positively to the Korowal community.
 - The child's readiness to engage positively in a Kindergarten learning environment.
 - Individual family circumstances as part of the overall application.
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Application Process

Applications should be submitted by **Friday, 14 August 2026**.

Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee.

Shortlisted families will be invited to:

- Meet with the Principal.
- Attend a Kindergarten visit with their child.
- Discuss how the family and school will work together in partnership.

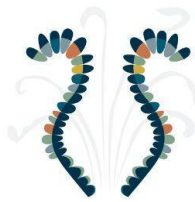
Successful applicants will then proceed through Korowal's standard enrolment process.
